A high-level overview of CCS eligibility requirements are as follows, this summary does not take into account all eligibility factors: families must be a Maryland resident who is working and/or attending an approved training or educational program; a recipient of Temporary Cash Assistance, Supplemental Security Income or within the Child Care Subsidy Income Guidelines; willing to have their child immunized to Maryland state standards; and pursuing child support, if there is an absent parent from the home. Parents must complete the application process within 30 days of submitting an application to CCS Central, by fax, mail or email. Eligible families then receive payment vouchers from Child Care Subsidy Central to cover part of their child care costs. Families take the voucher to a child care provider that participates in the Maryland EXCELS program. The voucher is a signed agreement between the state of Maryland, the provider and parent.
